JOB FAMILY: INDUSTRY LIAISON Level G, Pay Grade 13

LEVEL DEFINITION	This level covers positions representing the university and providing leadership and strategic direction through the development and commercialization of research and technology, technology commercialization, and the formation of spin-off companies.
TYPICAL RESPONSIBILITIES	May include: providing leadership and strategic direction for the assigned technology transfer group; setting the goals and directions for major initiatives; setting direction for the commercialization of University technology; guiding the formation of spin-off companies.
DECISION MAKING /LEVEL OF ACCOUNTABILITY	Makes decisions regarding the strategic development and commercialization of technologies and the formation of spin-off companies, as well as the direction and implementation of major special initiatives.
SUPERVISION RECEIVED	Works at the executive level to meet broad mandates. Work is reviewed in terms of achievement of long-term strategic goals and the fulfillment of broad mandates.
SUPERVISION EXERCISED	Manages professionals and support staff. Manages external legal consultants.
MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS	Post Graduate degree in a related discipline. Minimum of ten years of experience in sponsored research and technology transfer including several years in a senior management position, or the equivalent combination of education and experience.
