



NEIGHBOURHOOD PROFILE – KERRISDALE

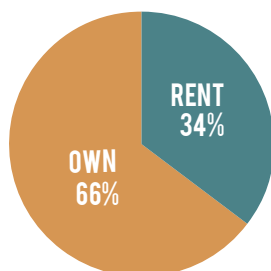

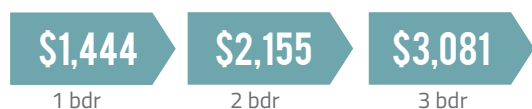

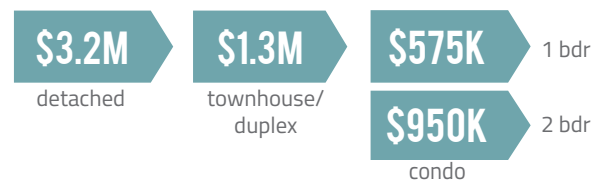
OWN VS. RENT



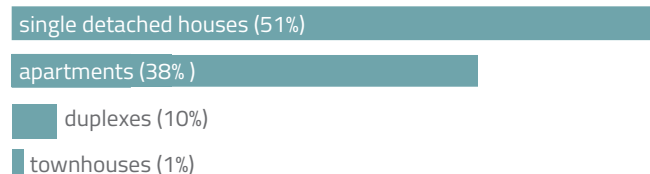
AVERAGE MONTHLY RENT



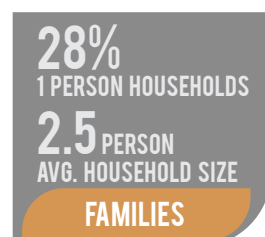
MEDIAN SOLD PRICE



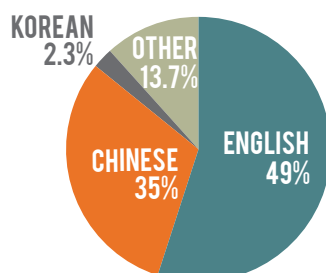
DWELLING TYPE



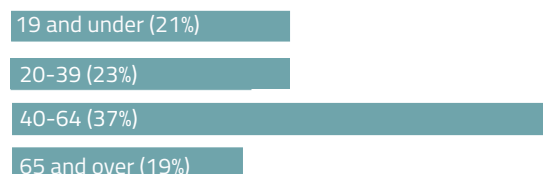

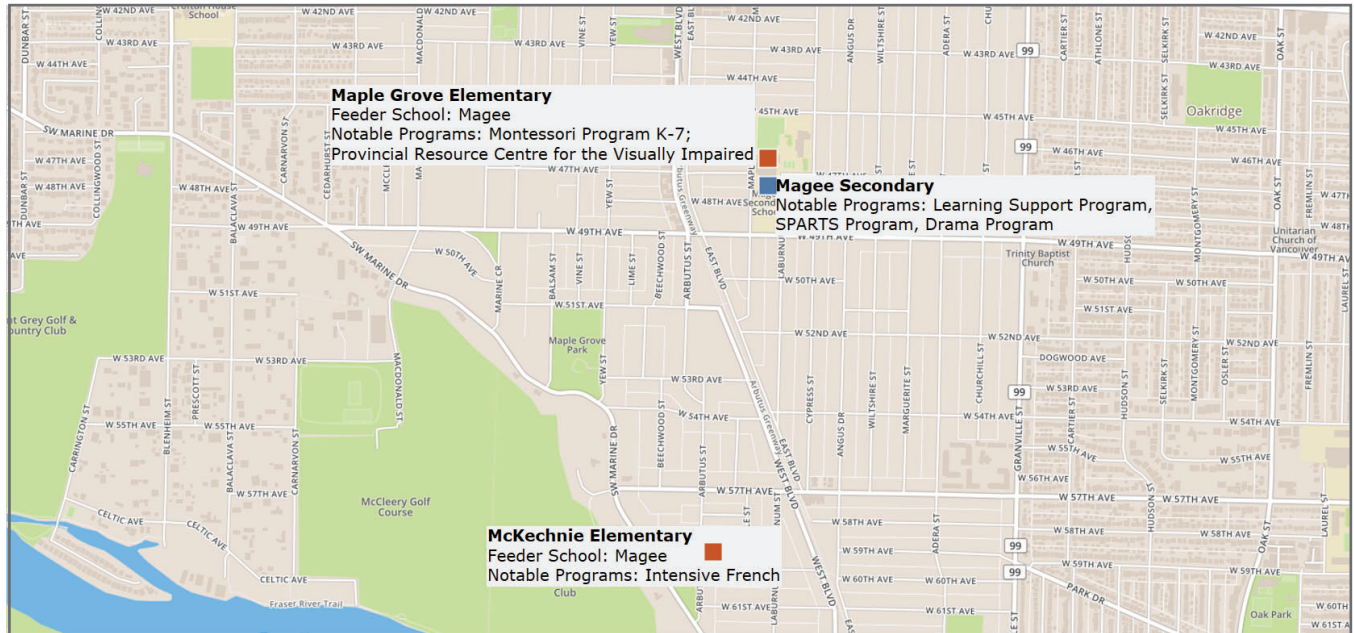
