



NEIGHBOURHOOD PROFILE – MOUNT PLEASANT

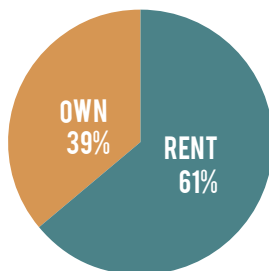
Mount Pleasant was Vancouver's first suburb and has undergone gentrification since the early 1990s, resulting in a remarkable assortment of historic buildings and modern developments. Storefronts along Main, Broadway, and Kingsway offer an eclectic mix of more than 350 shops and services, including unique boutiques, trendy eateries, hip cafés, and a number of emerging local craft beer breweries. With its lively character, diverse cultural landscape, and proximity to downtown, it is no wonder why Mount Pleasant is one of Vancouver's hottest residential markets.

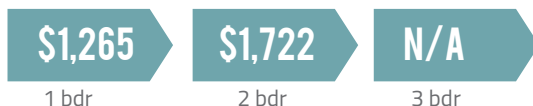

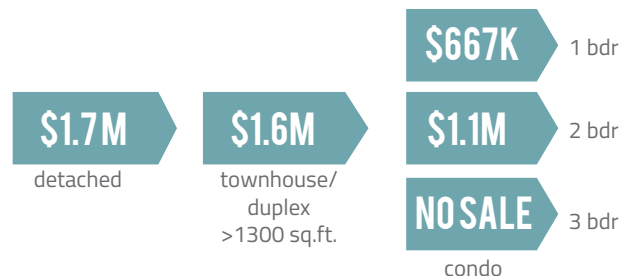
OWN VS. RENT



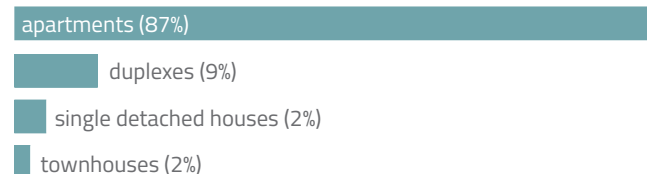
AVERAGE MONTHLY RENT



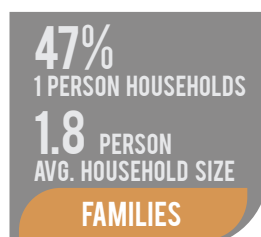
MEDIAN SOLD PRICE



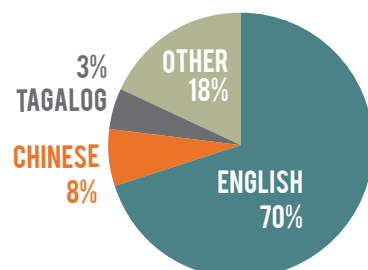
DWELLING TYPE



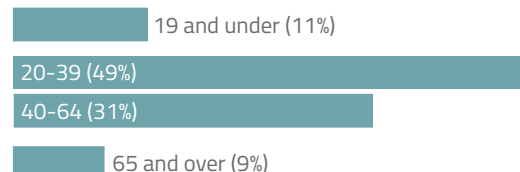

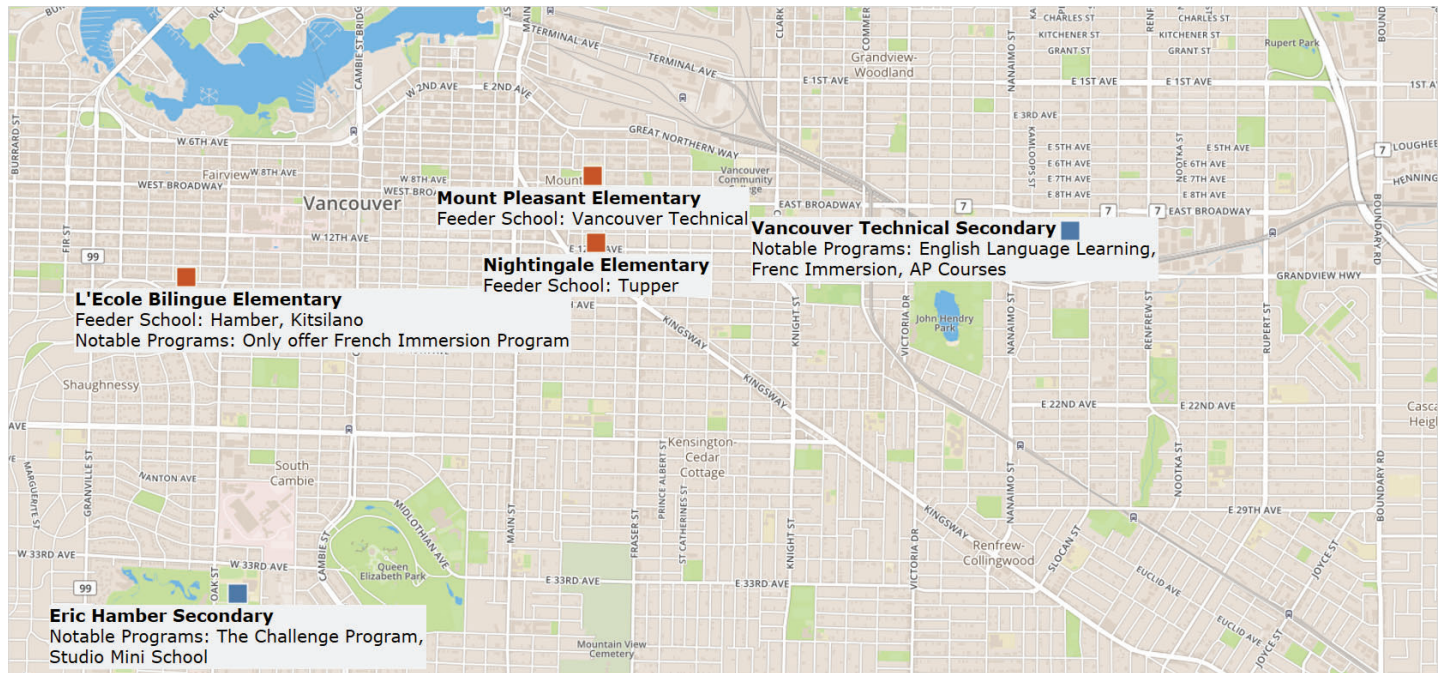
